An estimated 11.3 million undocumented people living in the United States have no pathway to citizenship.

Between 2011 and 2016, the number of people fleeing the Northern Triangle seeking refuge in neighboring countries increased by 2,249 percent.

Since 2016, 24 migrants have died in ICE custody. And, under the 'Zero Tolerance' policy, 2,654 children were separated from their parents by the federal government.

Since 1986, the United States has spent \$263 billion on border enforcement, including \$8.43 million a day on immigrant detention.
