## HOWEVER:

An estimated **11.3 million** undocumented people living in the United States have no pathway to citizenship.

Between **2011** and **2016**, the number of people fleeing the Northern Triangle seeking refuge in neighboring countries increased by **2,249 percent**.

Since **2016**, **24** migrants have died in ICE custody. And, under the 'Zero Tolerance' policy, **2,654** children were separated from their parents by the federal government.

Since **1986**, the United States has spent **\$263 billion** on border enforcement, including **\$8.43 million a day** on immigrant detention.
